

It is the largest museum in the world which houses French works, Italian, Spanish, Flemish and English from the Middle Ages to the eighteenth century but also the famous Joconde. Distance: 2 km

The Orsay museum, housed in a former train station, is dedicated to the art of the nineteenth century and the most famous impressionists: Monet, Renoir, Caillebotte, Manet, Sisley, Gauguin and Degas. Distance: 2.5 km

This museum, which is no stranger to controversy, has recently undergone complete renovation and is one of the most outstanding museums in Europe. Distance: 5 km

Considered the symbol of Paris, it was constructed in 1889 in occasion of the World's Fair, which marked the centenary of the French Revolution. It offers stunning views of the entire capital. Distance: 3 km

Erected in the twelfth century, the cathedral is built in Flamboyant Gothic style. Middle Island Ile Saint-Louis, this small island has many mansions of the sixteenth and seventeenth centuries. Distance: 5 km

The Sacred Heart of Montmartre offers the most beautiful view of the rooftops of Paris. The basilica is in the Place du Tertre. Distance: 7 km

The Palace of Versailles was the home of the French royal family for three centuries. Visit the Hall of Mirrors, the Trianons and the famous Marie Antoinette sheepfold. Distance: 23 km

Built for King Francis I, the magnificent Château de Chantilly is in Renaissance style. On your return, stop at Senlis, a charming medieval city. Distance: 44 km

Fontainebleau was the summer residence of the kings of France. This is where Napoleon spent his last night before his exile to the island of St. Helena. Distance: 70 km

It took 31 months to build the Stade de France. Completed in January 1998, it was inaugurated by President Jacques Chirac and has 60 000 seats. Distance: 12 km
