Private Tour with Car: Tour to Egyptian Museum, Citadel and Khan El Khalili Bazaar

**Description:** Start your tour by visiting the Egyptian Museum. Designed by the French architect Marcel Dourgnon, the museum is located in a stunning neo-classical building on Tahrir Square. Its collections exceed 120,000 masterpieces, ranging from the pre-dynastic era to the Pharaonic and Greco-Roman periods. You will get to see Saladin Citadel, designed by the Turkish architect Yousif Boushnaq, who came to Cairo especially from Istanbul to build this impressive building. The mosque's alabaster structure stands in beautiful contrast to the sandstone city. Continue to the Khan el-Khalili Bazaar, one of the oldest bazaars in the Middle East. Discover a maze of alleys that have been at the center of Cairo's trading activities since the 14th century. You will have time to relax over lunch at a local restaurant.

Cruise: 5 Day / 4 Night Sun Goddess from Luxor to Aswan

**Description:** Explore Egypt's rich history and 5 000 years of myths and legends during an unforgettable Nile Cruise. Day 1 - After you embark and relax in your cabin, you will start your journey with lunch onboard and a visit to the Temples of Karnak & Luxor. Recharge after a day of exploration over a scrumptious dinner on board and live music in the lounge. Overnight in Luxor.

Day 2 – Start your day with an early morning visit to the West Bank including the Valley of the Kings, the Valley of the Queens, the Temple of Queen Hatshepsut at Deir El Bahari. Upon returning to the ship, you sail towards Esna. Lunch and dinner on board, captain's cocktail party, and entertainment onboard. Overnight in Esna.

Day 3- After breakfast, you will explore the Edfu temple. This Ptolemaic temple, built between 237 and 57 BC, is one of the best-preserved ancient monuments in Egypt. Preserved by desert sand, which filled the place after the pagan cult was banned, the temple is dedicated to Horus, the avenging son of Isis and Osiris. With its roof intact, it is also one of the most atmospheric ancient buildings. After returning to the ship, you will sail towards Kom Ombo and after the afternoon tea, you will visit this famous site. Kom Ombo is one of the Nile Valley's most beautifully sited temples. Unique in Egypt, it is dedicated to two gods: the local crocodile god Sobek, and Haroeris, meaning Horus the Elder. Dinner will be served on board, and you will spend the night in Kom Ombo.

Day 4 - Aswan: Visit the High Dam, the Granite Quarries with the Unfinished Obelisk, and the Temple of Philae. Experience the ancient method of sailing across the Nile on a felucca, a typical Egyptian sailboat, and view Kitchener's Island. Afternoon tea, Nubian show, and dinner on board, overnight in Aswan.


Day 5 - Aswan: Breakfast on board, which will be followed by disembarkation.

With your licensed Egyptologist, you will get to visit the colossal Temple of Ramses II and the temple of his beloved Queen Nefertari, both temples carved out of a hillside beside the Nile in the 13th century BC. Continuing your day with a gourmet lunch before your return flight.
