



Orléans – Saint-Denis-de-l'Hôtel Airport Factsheet

Orléans – Saint-Denis-de-l'Hôtel Airport (IATA: **ORE**, ICAO: **LFOZ**) is a French airport located in the Saint-Denis-de-l'Hôtel commune in the Loiret département, Centre-Val de Loire region, France.

The airport is on the northern part of the commune of Saint-Denis-de-l'Hôtel, in the Loire Valley, north of the Loire river and south of the Orléans forest.

Facilities

The airport essentially serves business aircraft, though tourist aviation also contributes a significant part of the traffic.

The airport is situated at an elevation of 396 feet (121 m) above mean sea level.

It has one Runway: **05/23** with an asphalt surface measuring **1,600m by 30m (5,249 ft × 98 ft)**

Runways are served by NDB and GPS/Rnav Approaches.

The Airport handles Business Jets ranging from Very Light (citation etc) to Heavy Jets such as Bombardier Global 6000 and Gulfstream G550/650 by appointment only
