Iconic villages of Santorini

Oia town	<p>A traditional settlement in the north of Santorini. Also known as 'Apano Meria' or 'Anomeria' and the inhabitants are called 'Apanomerites'. The village is approximately 150 meters above sea level. Oia is one of the most photographed places in Greece, if not the world. It has inspired artists, poets and every visitor who visits Santorini. It is best known for breathtaking sunsets; if truth be told, sunrise in Oia is also magical.</p>
Fira town	<p>Fira is the beautiful capital of the island and the biggest and most cosmopolitan settlement of Santorini. It is located in the western edge of the island, opposite the volcano and the two volcanic islands, Palaia Kammeni and Nea Kammeni that lie in the sea. Fira is a combination of natural beauty, social life, night life, and shopping, where you can feel the liveliness of the island and where all the action takes place. What makes it so ravishing is the Caldera view that leaves visitors speechless anytime of the day.</p>
Imerovigli	<p>Also known as "The balcony to the Aegean", is built on the highest point of the caldera cliffs, about 300 meters above sea level. Its position provides a magnificent view of the famous volcano, the sparkling Aegean Sea and the sunset that is out of this world.</p>
Pyrgos	<p>The largest preserved village on Santorini and the island's former capital. Strategically built in the heart of the pre-volcanic hinterland and at the foot of Mt Profitis Ilias, Pyrgos affords panoramic views. Pyrgos is not swamped by sunset spotters, nor is it the first choice among the hordes of cruise-ship passengers. Its charm is different: more subdued, less picture-perfect, little advertised.</p>
Megalochori	<p>A traditional village at a strategic position in the center of the island, which hosts nice old mansions, vineyards, three wineries & some restaurants with good local cuisine. The history of the village dates back to 17th century and is known for the sweet red wine Vinsanto which is produced here and exported to the whole world.</p>



beaches of santorini

Perissa-Perivolos	Those in search of a break that's rich in traditional island holiday appeal will be right at home in Perissa. Set along the east coast of Santorini, the region offers a wonderful expanse of volcanic black-sand beaches filled with sun loungers, beach bars and cultural sights. Unlike the cliffside towns of Fira and Oia, Perissa has a quieter ambience that's ideal for relaxing with family and friends. (20 min from NOÛS Santorini)
Vlychada Beach	Vlychada is an easily accessible beach, located on the south coast of Santorini. It features a lengthy beach with dark volcanic sand and pebbles, like most beaches in Santorini. Visitors can relax at the bar-restaurant located there, a secluded sea front setting ,for every moment of the day.
Kamari Beach	Kamari Beach is one of the most popular and most visited beach resorts in Santorini. It is located in the seaside village of Kamari, 10 kilometers southeast of Fira and close to the Airport. It is easily accessible by bus that departs from Fira and the rest of the island and there is a big parking lot where you can leave your vehicle. The beach is composed of black volcanic sand and is 5 kilometers long, among the 3 longest beaches in Santorini, with deep crystalline waters and a series of trees It is fully organized with hundreds of sunbeds and umbrellas, showers, a lifeguard on duty and numerous facilities. The lively atmosphere at the numerous cafes, bars, restaurants and night clubs by the sea can offer you an enjoyable time. The beach is ideal for everyone, of all ages, and is a wondrous typical beach of Santorini, the volcanic island.



museums and historical sites

Museum of Prehistoric Thera, Fira

Great Museum in the heart of Fira with displays featuring art, artifacts, and jewelry from the ancient villages of Akrotiri in Santorini and Potamos in Crete.

Open April to October, 8:30am to 3:30pm.
→ Closed on Tuesdays.

Ancient Thera, Kamari

Located on Mesa Vouno, this archaeological site of the ancient city of Thera is the second-most important site in Santorini after Akrotiri. The site is well-organized, and the views are magnificent.

Open year-round 8:30am to 3:30pm.
→ Closed on Wednesdays.

Lost Atlantis Museum, Megalochori

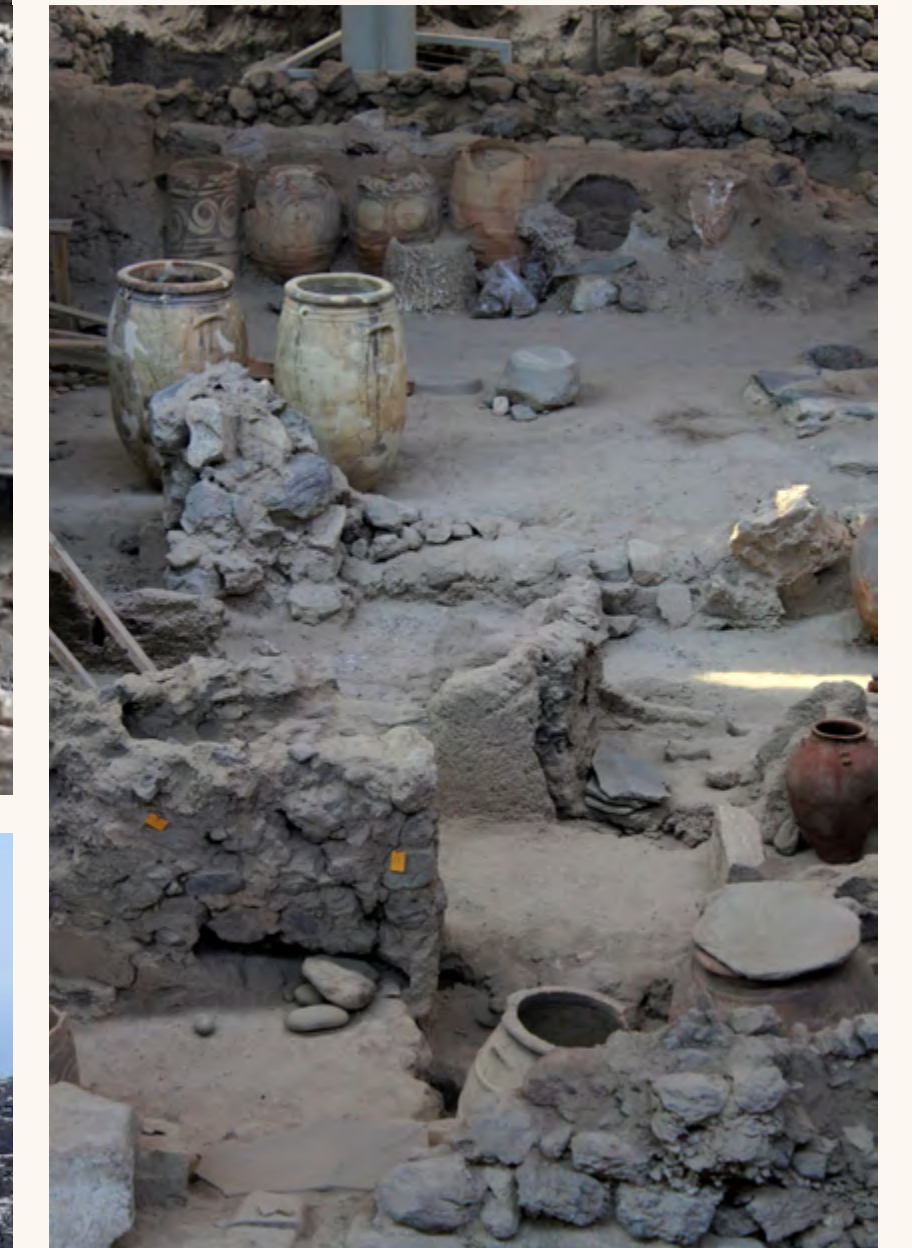
Modern Museum using interactive digital installations, holograms, and a 9D movie theater to explore the mythological island of Atlantis. Small souvenir shop.

Open April to October, 10am to 7pm.

Archaeological Site of Akrotiri, Akrotiri

Well-preserved ruins of the ancient city of Akrotiri which was destroyed by a massive earthquake and buried under ash from the subsequent volcano in 17th-century BC. The site is enclosed, with elevated and accessible walkways throughout.

Open April to October, 8:30am to 3:30pm.

best wineries of santorini

<u>Venetsanos Winery</u> Caldera Megalochori	Where the sky meets the sea and the earth greets life force, where the vines bestow their fate to the sun and the soul surrenders to the senses. Have a wine tasting or even lunch overlooking the breathtaking cliffside of Caldera.
<u>Domaine Sigalas</u> Baxes, Oia	Domaine Sigalas is one of the most renowned wineries in not only Santorini, but in all of Greece, with internationally acclaimed wine labels that have won numerous awards and obtained a score of over 90 points on the rating system. Located on a peaceful vineyard of Oia, the tasting area of the Domaine Domaine is open daily, with some tables on the patio right under vine-covered pergolas. At day's end, visitors have the opportunity to enjoy the world-famous Oia sunset.
<u>Hatzidakis Winery</u> Kallisti, Pyrgos	The manpower of the Winery continues to produce quality wines in limited quantities, always aiming at the island's terroir expression, through the indigeNOÛS grape varieties of Santorini, fermenting only with indigeNOÛS yeasts. The winery each self is located in a huge cave inside the mountain, creating the ideal environment for the natural aging of their wines, which are then bottled UNFILTERED.
<u>Estate Argyros Winery</u> Episkopi Gonias	One of the oldest families to be involved in the art of creating wine, Argyros family has the largest private owner of vineyards in Santorini and the current landholdings exceed 120 ha, a vast, four-generations-long investment. With respect to a very long family tradition but also cutting-edge technology, Estate Argyros produces top quality highly awarded wines.

Island Tours

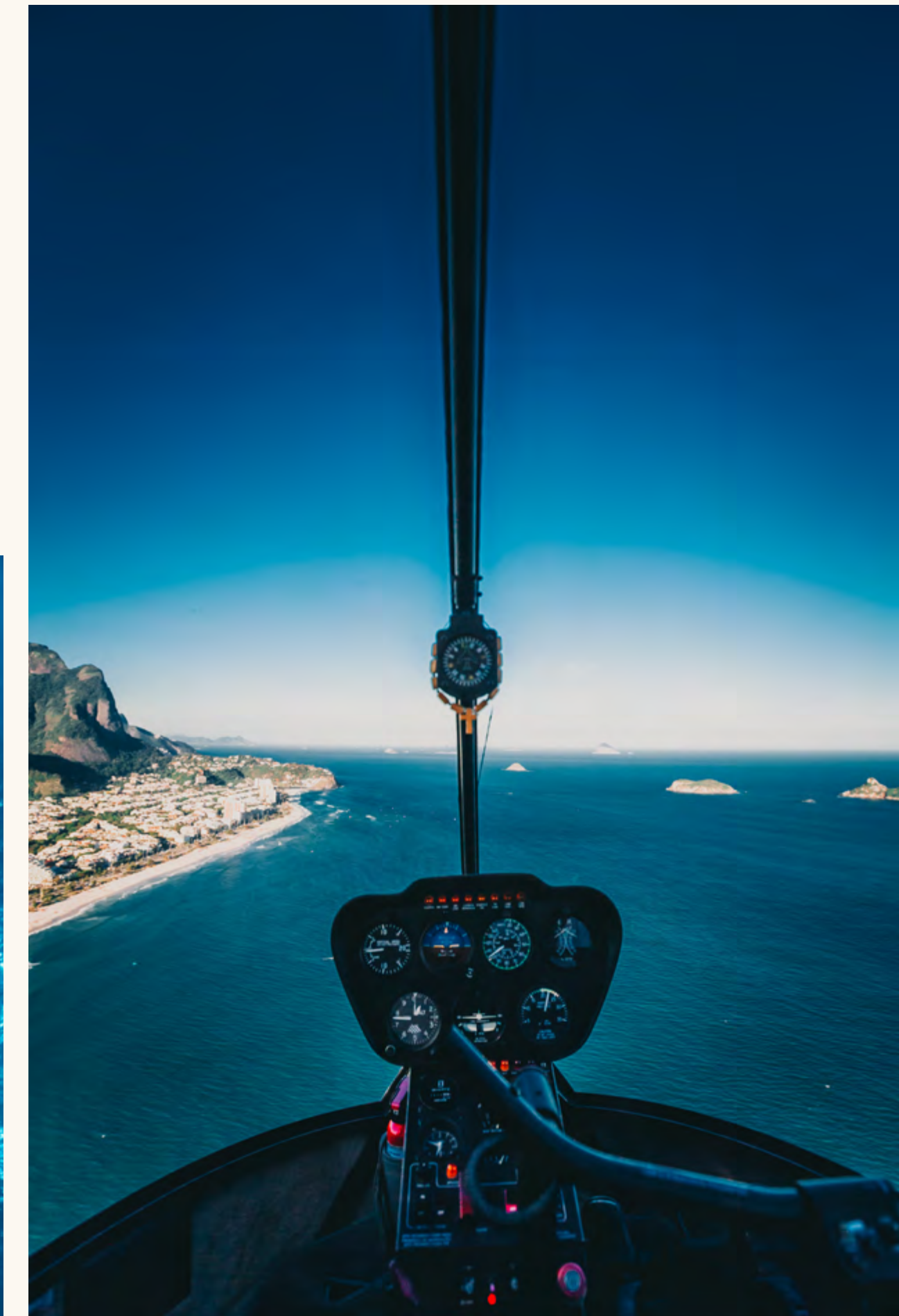

If action and adrenaline is your way of relaxing and spending your vacation, the island of Santorini has exactly what you need.

Santorini is laced with scenery-rich hiking routes, many offering a crowd-free insight into this snap-worthy Cycladic isle.

Walk on cobbled streets past quaint settlements, amid lush vineyards or on top of an active volcano. Whether you're after a challenging or more relaxed walk, the following trails unveil the island's sublime landscapes and rich history, every step of the way.

Hiking

Fira to Oia:

This 10km hiking route is the most popular one in Santorini. Take in Fira's opulent beauty, pass by the blue-crowned Church of Saint Gerasimos in Firostefani, and marvel at Imerovigli's fortressed Skaros Rock, and continue north amid white-blue chapels, caldera views and paved alleyways until captivating Oia village is in sight. (3-4 hours).

Pyrgos to Prophet Elias Monastery:

Offering panoramic views of Santorini from up high, this 1-mile (1.6km) cobbled path will lead you to the island's highest point (1.5 hours).

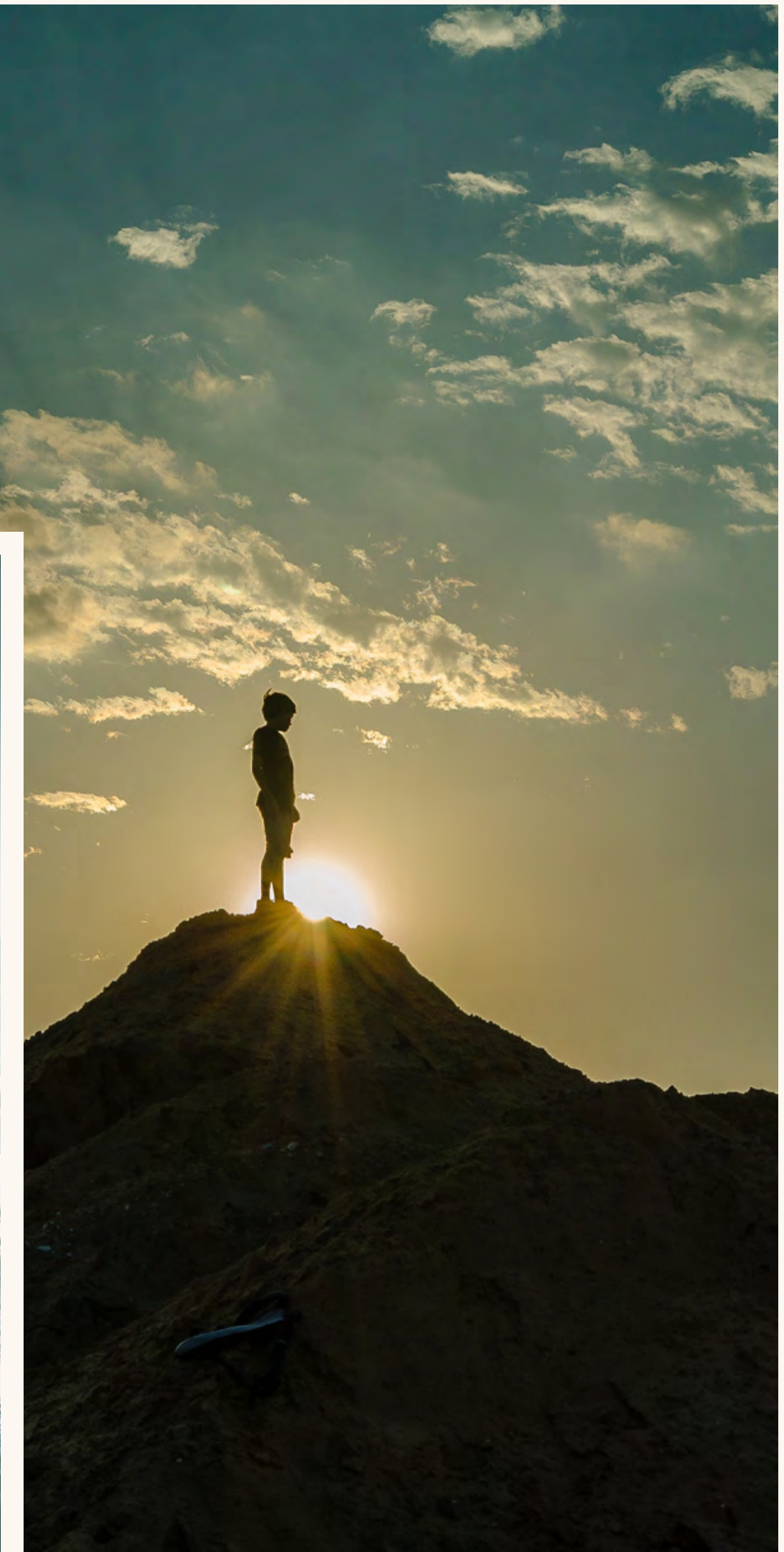
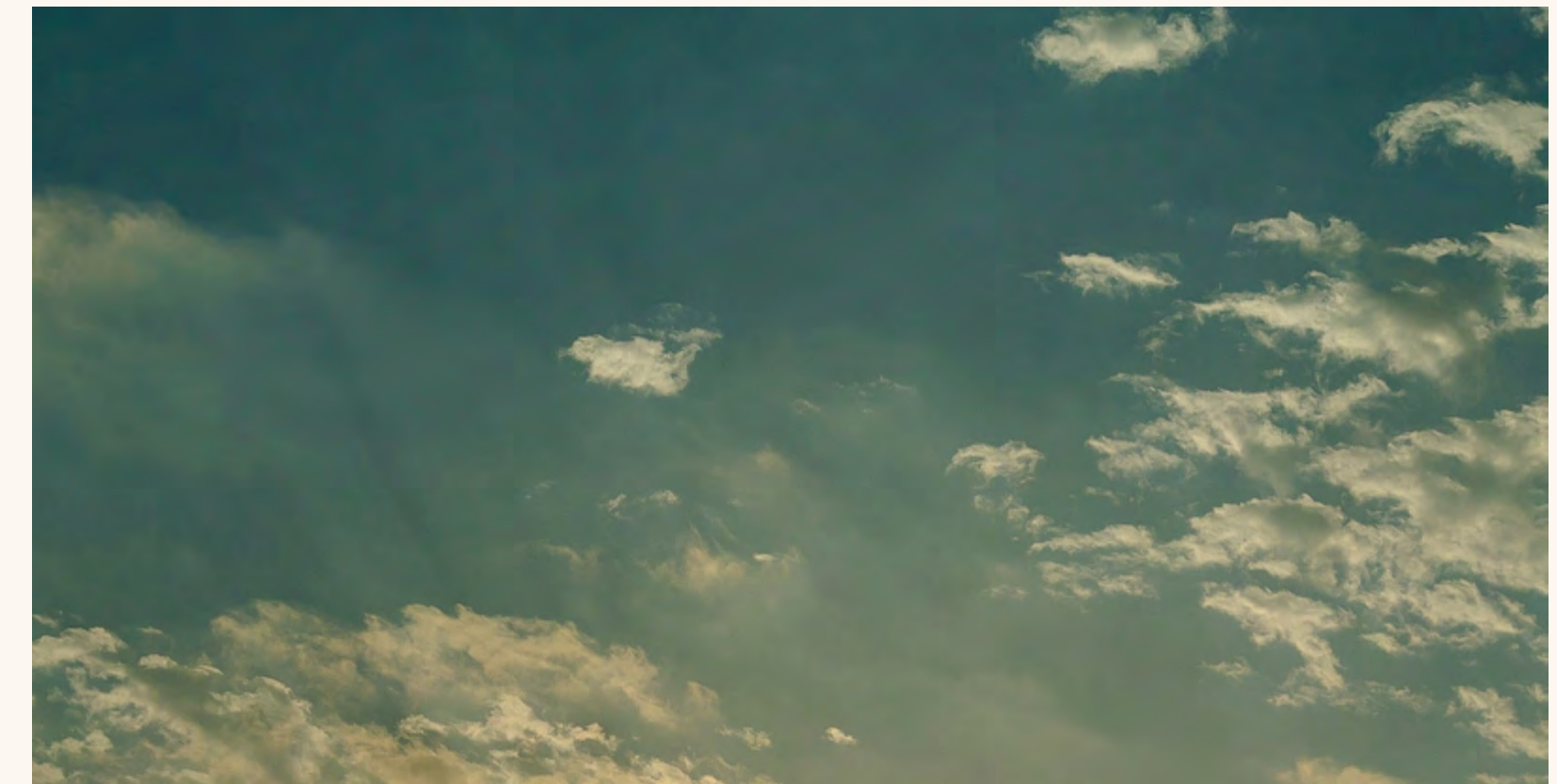
Ancient Thera to Perissa Beach:

Walk among the well-preserved ruins of the civilization of Ancient Thera by following the two-mile (3.2km) downhill path to Perissa black beach with stunning view over the cliff. (1-2 hours).

Jet ski tours, Parasailing, Wakeboard, Hoverboard, Windsurfing, Flyboard, Canoe, Paddle boats and many more

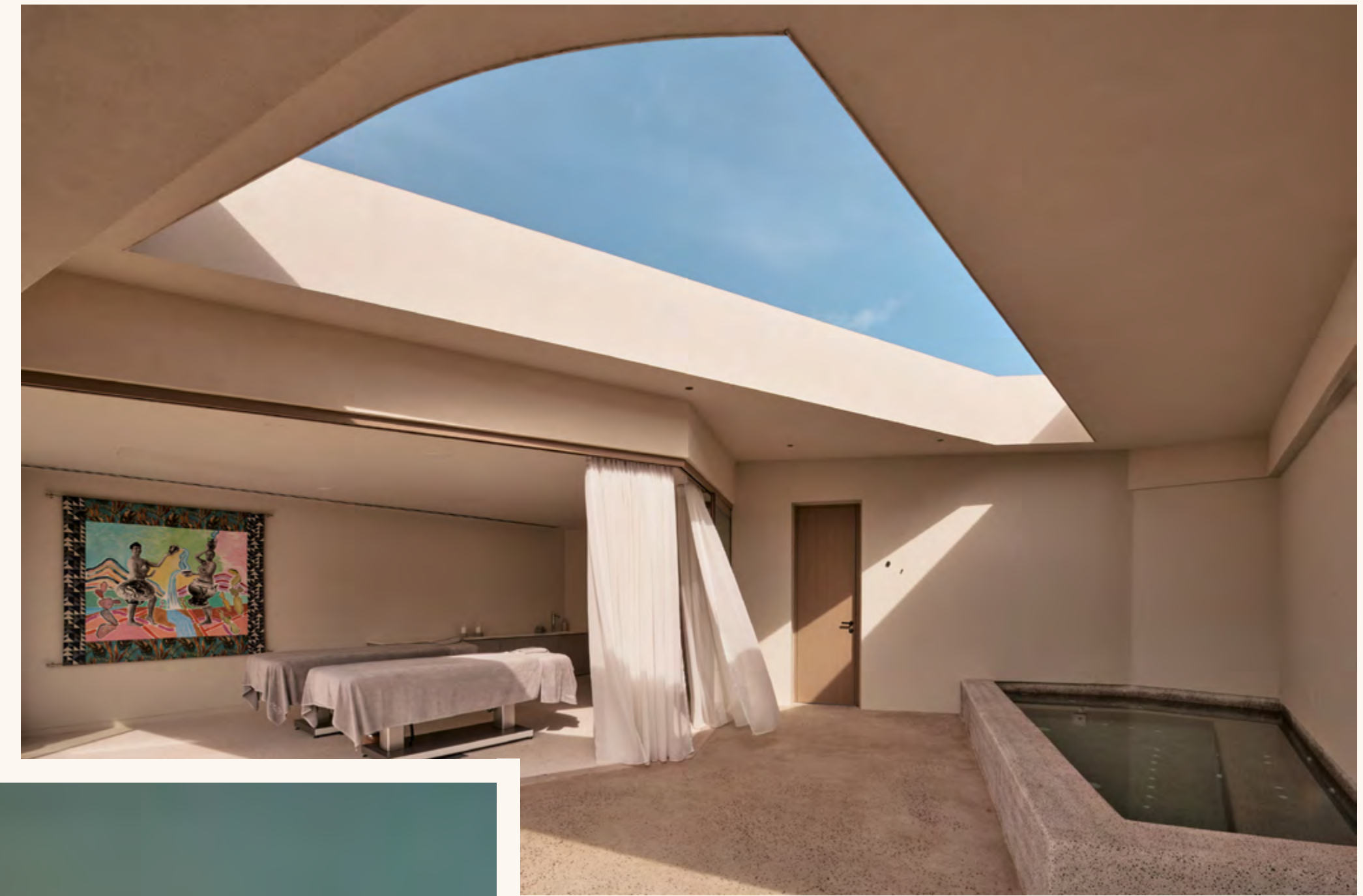

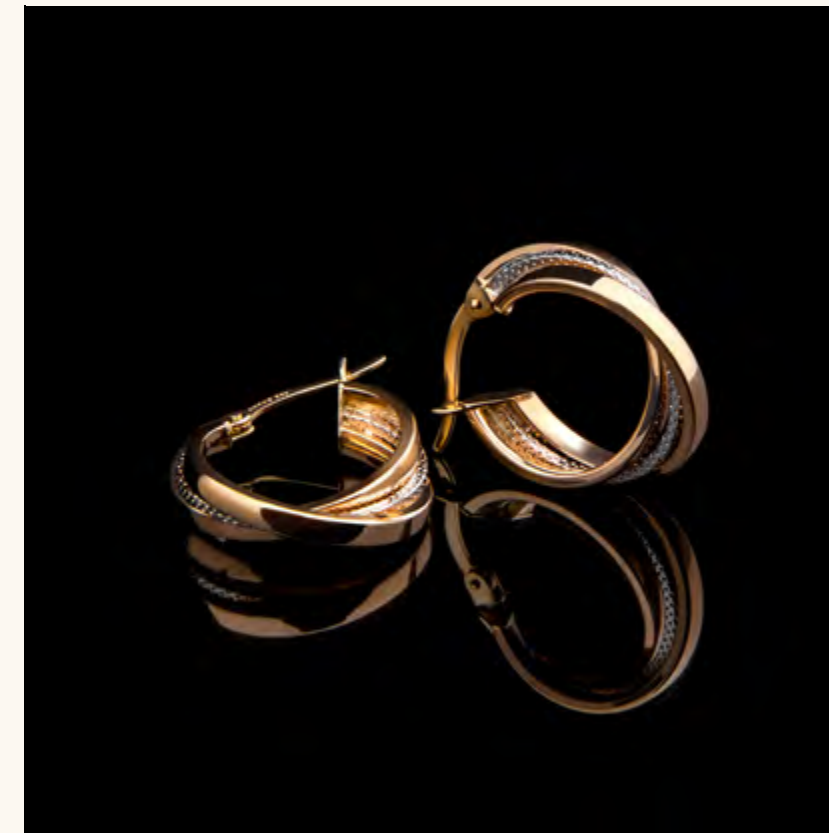
