

The excellent central location of Cornaro hotel, its ancient history surroundings, and interior elegance are complemented by discreet placement of the latest technology thoughtfully integrated throughout each room and hotel facilities. Cornaro is situated just a two-minute walk inland from Zlatna Vrata (the Golden Gate), the main entrance to Split's car-free Old Town, which centers on the third-century Diocletian's Palace. All the main attractions are nearby, but you're away from the summer crowds and the hustle and bustle of the seafront (Riva). With its 151 rooms, 4 junior suites and 1 premium suite, the diverse and elegant Cornaro Hotel boasts sensible design thus introducing new trends. Cornaro offers two restaurants with terraces for open-air dining, a rooftop bar affording fantastic views, a private wine bar for tasting, a small wellness center and gym in the basement.





Private Tour with Car: Tour to Split, Salona and Trogir

Description: Embark on a tour of three exceptional historical towns Split, Trogir and Salona, all located within a 30 km stretch of the Dalmatian coast. After your transfer from the hotel to the Split city center, you will meet your private guide and step inside the UNESCO World Heritage Site Diocletian's Palace, one of the world's most impressive Roman monuments built for the Roman emperor Diocletian at the turn of the fourth century AD. Wander through the still very lively narrow streets inside the palace, explore the grandiose palace cellars, the 4 palace gates, the Jewish Ghetto, rub the toe of the Grgur Ninski statue and learn more about the fascinating history of the city and the infamous Emperor. Your history lesson will continue with a visit to Salona, the capital of the Roman province of Dalmatia some 2000 years ago, and one of the five largest cities in the entire Roman empire. Explore the large Roman amphitheater which was fit for a city of 60.000 at its peak, Manastirine, a necropolis that was used from the 2nd century BC until the destruction of the city in the 7th century, and many other sites within this live archaeological park. Your next destination is Trogir, a small island town that was founded by the ancient Greek settlers in the 3rd century BC. Trogir is an excellent example of a medieval town built on and conforming with the layout of a Hellenistic and Roman city that has conserved its urban with the minimum of modern interventions, earning it the status of a UNESCO World Heritage Site. For centuries, Trogir was a place where numerous artists left their mark, leaving an imprint inside the city's soul. From its famous St. Laurence Cathedral portal to the Venetian fortifications used to fight off the invaders, this small city will leave a lasting impression.

Private Single-Day Cruise: Brac and Šolta Island Yacht Tour on Lema Duna 29

Description: This full day of island hopping on board a private yacht will enable you to experience some of the most fascinating islands and islets in Central Dalmatia including Brac and Solta. After meeting your driver at the hotel lobby you will head to the Split harbor where you will board the boat and get acquainted with the full itinerary. The captain will first set sail to the quaint town of Milna on island Brac, filled with historical sights, scenic beauty, and the irresistible charm of a typical Dalmatian fishing town. Wander around this postcard-worthy town and relax in one of the small cafes with a cup of espresso and watch the world go by, just like the locals. You will then head back to the boat for a swim stop in one of the secluded bays near Milna. Your next destination will be the island of Solta, passing several small islets along the way, including the true hidden gems in Dalmatia, Vela Rina bay on island Drvenik Mali and the famous Blue Lagoon on the island of Drvenik Veli. The Blue Lagoon is nestled between the two islets (Krknjaš Mali and Krknjaš Veli) and one island (Drvenik Veli) and offers perfect swimming conditions sheltered from winds and waves. After another swim stop, you will reach Solta and the quaint town of Necujam located in the biggest bay on the island. Explore the town or ask your captain for a restaurant recommendation. Return to Split in the afternoon.




Private Guide Service: Game of Thrones in Dubrovnik and Red Keep Discovery Tour

Description: With your professional guide, explore the unique locations in Dubrovnik and its surroundings used as set locations for Game of Thrones. First discover the locations of some of the most iconic GOT scenes in the old town, including; The Pile Gate, Lovrijenac, also known as the Red Keep, fortified walls of King's Landing, Gradac park -the Purple wedding setting, Belvedere atrium - trial by combat scene, the Jesuit steps – location of the Walk of Shame, Bokar and Min?eta forts – the House of the Undying. You will then continue to Trsteno, a quaint seaside town on the outskirts of Dubrovnik, famous for its postcard-worthy Arboretum. Spanning over 70 acres with over 450 species of plant life, the Trsteno Arboretum is the oldest and biggest monument of garden architecture in Croatia. Because of its seaside location and natural beauty, Trsteno was selected as the perfect setting for the Tyrell high garden. After the tour of the grounds, your driver will transfer you back to the hotel.

Private Tour with Car: Pelješac Wine Tasting Tour

Description: Peljesac Wine Tour takes you to the beautiful Pelješac peninsula, home to some of the most intriguing red wines. The tour includes a trio of wine-tasting opportunities in some of Croatia's most respected wine cellars and field visits to their vineyards on the picturesque slopes of this magnificent peninsula. Your first wine tasting experience will be in the Matusko winery, where you will get a chance to taste red & white wines and their legendary Dingac, made from 100% Plavac Mali grapes. Next, you will visit the Grgic winery in Trstenik. Miljenko Grgich studied wine-making in Zagreb. After migrating to the US, with only \$20 in his pocket, he founded now world-famous Grgich Hills winery in Napa Valley. While you visit the Grgic cellars, you will taste their famous white Posip and red Plavac Mali Dingac. The last winery is Madirazza, which made a name for itself with its stunning vineyards and excellent wines.
