


Private Tour with Car: Truffle Hunting and the Jewels of Istria



Private Guide Service: The Secrets of Zagreb City Tour

Description: Discover the essence of Croatia's capital as you explore its streets and most iconic landmarks. Famous for its Austro-Hungarian architecture and its numerous parks, the city of Zagreb has developed around two neighboring hills, Gradec and Kaptol or Upper and Lower Town. Today, the two are connected with The Blue Funicular, the shortest funicular in the world. Accompanied by a private guide you will explore the Cathedral built in neo-Gothic style and one of the most valuable monuments of Croatian cultural heritage, the Church of St. Mark with its famous roof, Lotrš?ak tower, Strossmayer promenade, and picturesque winding streets filled with vibrant terraces and souvenir shops. Continue to the Bloody Bridge, a small street that connects Tkal?i?eva street and Radi?eva street, both made famous by the first Croatian female journalist Marija Juri? Zagorka in her novel Secret of the Bloody Bridge, which contributed to the spread of an old legend. Your next destinations are the King Tomislav Square with it's neo-Classical and Secessionist buildings and palaces, and Ban Jela?i? square, the central spot in the city, colorful Dolac farmers market, Croatian National Theatre, and Ilica street, the main shopping area in the city.

Private Tour with Car: Crossover with Slovenia - Zagreb to Ljubljana and Bled Lake

Description: Today is the perfect day to visit neighboring Slovenia and some of its most iconic destinations. Just a 2-hour scenic drive from Zagreb you will find the postcard-worthy lake Bled, nestled between the Julian Alps and lush forests. The lake surrounds Bled Island, and a boat will be waiting to take you across. The island has several prominent buildings, and your boat will dock near the pilgrimage church dedicated to the Assumption of Mary. Built near the end of the 17th century, decorated with remains of Gothic frescos from 1470 in the presbyterium and rich Baroque equipment. The church has a 52 m tower and there is a Baroque stairway from 1655 with 99 stone steps leading up to the top of the island, presenting you with stunning panoramic views. The legend says whoever rings the bell in the tower will have their wish come true, so make sure you include some bell ringing on your to-do list. Once your camera is filled with photos, you will continue your Slovenian adventure in the country's capital – Ljubljana. This mid-sized European city has preserved its small-town friendliness and relaxed atmosphere while providing all the facilities of a modern capital. Explore the city's vibrant center, take a walk by the Ljubljanica river or visit Ljubljana castle before your journey back to Zagreb.
